All Premiership, Championship and registered Kittens entries will be scored for CFA National and Regional Awards. **Kittens may be shown without a CFA registration number however their wins will not be scored for the National or Regional Awards.** All claws must be clipped prior to benching. No declawed entries are permitted. Cats or kittens must be clean and free of fungus, fleas, ear mites, and any contagious or infectious disease. This is not a vetted show. However, all entries should have current inoculations against feline enteritis, calici, panleukopenia and rhinotracheitis (please have your cat' health certificates with you). Advertised show hours are 10-5 Saturday and 9-4 Sunday.

*All cats must have current inoculations, including rabies, to cross the Canadian border. Please have the necessary health certificates.
