ENTRY FEES: Each entry must be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee. Please make checks or money orders payable in US funds to BUTLER CAT FANCIERS. The entry clerk will phone *collect* to clarify any entries. **\$25.00 CHARGE ON ALL RETURNED CHECKS!** Entries submitted within 10 days of the show and paying at the door pursuant to Show Rule 4.07, **MUST PAY IN CASH AT CHECK-IN.**

CLOSING DATE: October 29, 2013, at NOON, or when 225 entries have been received.

SHOW HOURS: Check-in is 7:30-8:30 am. Cats not checked in by 8:45 will be marked absent.

Judging will begin at 9:00. Show hours are from 9-4 pm. Butler Cat Fanciers, Inc. will take reasonable care of cats & property, but is not liable for loss or damage. All Championship, Premiership & registered Kittens will be scored for CFA National & Regional awards. CFA Show Rules will be strictly enforced. The club reserves the right to add judges not named in this flyer to judge non-Championship & non- Premiership classes. The club will provide litter sufficient for each entry. Show hall will be heated or air-conditioned, as appropriate. No smoking is allowed in the areas where cats are benched & where judging is held. People food will be available.

The show hall is handicapped accessible, heated and air-conditioned. This is a non-vetted show. Claws of all entries must be clipped prior to benching. All entries must be free of fleas, fungus, mites and infectious diseases; inoculated against feline rhinotracheitis, feline enteritis, rabies and calici viruses; and tested for feline leukemia before entry. Any entry suspected of having a parasite, skin disease or other illness will be removed from the show hall until cleared by a veterinarian, whose decision is final. Household Pets must be 4 months old to be entered and if over the age of 8 months must be neutered or spayed. No declawed cats are permitted. **No kittens under 4 months of age will be allowed in the show hall**. Single cages are approx. 22 x 22 x 22. **Novice Exhibitors**: Let us know if you are new to showing and we can assist you. Please bring cage curtains, grooming aids, your own litter pans and food. People food will be available. Litter will be provided. All cats must be brought to the show hall in some sort of carrier.

All championship, premiership and kitten entries with registration numbers or temporary registration numbers will be scored for CFA National and Regional points. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number.
