Entry Fees: Kittens, Championship, Premier & Veterans First Entry, \$60.00 2 <sup>nd</sup> Entry, \$50.00 3 <sup>rd</sup> Entry, \$45.00	Cages: Single 21x21x21; Double 21x21x45 No more than 1 cat or 2 kittens may be benched in a single cage.
Each additional entry (same owner), \$40.00	Double Cage: \$25.00

**Online Entries:** No additional charge.

No refunds for failure to bench.

**Health information:** This is a non-vetted show. However, any entry found with fleas, ear mites, fungus or any signs of illness will not be admitted or will be removed from the show hall. Recommended that all cats and kittens be inoculated by licensed veterinarian against Feline Enteritis, Rhinotracheitis and Calici viruses, and Rabies and tested & found negative for FeLV before entry. All claws must be clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats not allowed.

**Awards:** Ribbons and rosettes will be awarded for all wins in accordance with CFA Show Rules. This show will be conducted in accordance with current CFA Show Rules. A copy of the CFA Show Rules may be obtained for \$7.00 from CFA. All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), Agility and registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Registration numbers must be printed in the catalog. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check the entry confirmation and notify the entry clerk of any errors before the closing date.

**Liability:** Although normal precautions will be taken, Call of the Wild and the Santa Rosa Fairgrounds will not be liable for damage, loss of personal property or personal injury.

**Cat Comfort**: Cat litter will be provided by the club at the show hall. Please bring your own litter boxes, cat food and dishes.

**Directions to Show Hall:** North or South on Hwy 101: Exit Hwy 12, Sebastopol/Sonoma off ramp. Take Hwy 12 East towards Sonoma. Exit Hwy 12 at South E Street/Downtown (the first exit you come to). This is Bennett Valley Rd. Show hall is the big pinkish building with the blue front on your right.

**Return to Hwy 101:** Bennett Valley Rd is one-way. Exit the Fairgrounds on Bennett Valley Rd. At the first light, Brookwood Ave, turn left. Turn left again on the next street, Maple Ave. Maple leads onto Hwy 12 W and easy access to North or South-bound Hwy 101.
