Show Hall: Grace Pavilion, Sonoma County Fairgrounds, 1350 Bennett Valley Rd., Santa Rosa, CA. Large, heated, plenty of room for wide aisles and a comfortable show. Coffee & donuts available a.m. Check www.srcatshow.com for food vendor availability. This is a no-smoking show hall.

Entry Fees:

Kittens, Championship, & Premier:

First Entry, \$60.00 2nd Entry, \$50.00 3rd Entry, \$45.00

Each additional entry (same owner), \$40.00

HHP & Veterans: \$40.00

(HHP/Vets are not included when calculating

discounts for non-HHP/Vet entries.)

AOV Entries: \$30.00

For Sale/Exhibition: \$25.00 w/competitive

entry.

Kittens must be at least 4 calendar months of age or older and comply with all other CFA show rules. For Sale or Exhibition entries must be on a signed, official CFA entry form or facsimile.

Cages:

Single 21x21x21; Double 21x21x45 No more than 1 cat or 2 kittens may be benched in a single cage.

Double Cage: \$25.00

All security cages, Singles & Doubles, require a double cage space. Double cage fee applies.

Grooming Space: \$25.00 End of Row requests: \$15.00 Returned check fee: \$25.00

Motels: There is no official show hotel. Santa Rosa and Rohnert Park have motels that accept cats.

Online Entries: No additional charge.

No refunds for failure to bench.

Health: This is a non-vetted show. We ask that all cats & kittens be current on all vaccinations (FVRCP, FeLV, etc.) Under current CFA Show Rules, show management reserves the right to have any cat showing signs of illness, disease or parasites removed from the show hall, in order to protect other cats in the show. All claws must be clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for entry. All Household Pet entries over 8 months of age must be spayed or neutered. No kitten under 4 months of age will be allowed in the show hall.

Awards: Ribbons and rosettes will be awarded for all wins in accordance with CFA Show Rules. A copy of the CFA Show Rules may be ordered from CFA. All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), Agility and registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Registration numbers must be printed in the catalog. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check the entry confirmation and notify the entry clerk of any errors before the closing date. Liability: Although normal precautions will be taken, Call of the Wild and the Santa Rosa Fairgrounds will not be liable for damage, loss of personal property or personal injury.

Cat Comfort: Cat litter will be provided by the club at the show hall. Please bring your own litter boxes, cat food and dishes.

Directions to Show Hall: North or South on Hwy 101: Exit Hwy 12, Sebastopol/Sonoma off ramp. Take Hwy 12 East towards Sonoma. Exit Hwy 12 at South E Street/Downtown (the first exit you come to). This is Bennett Valley Rd. Show hall is the big pinkish building with the blue front on your right.

Return to Hwy 101: Bennett Valley Rd is one-way. Exit the Fairgrounds on Bennett Valley Rd. At the first light, Brookwood Ave, turn left. Turn left again on the next street, Maple Ave. Maple leads onto Hwy 12 W and easy access to North or South-bound Hwy 101.
