Show Hours: Check-in is between 8:00 and 8:45 am. Judging will begin at 9:00 am. Cats not checked-in by 8:45 will be marked absent. The advertised show hours are 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 pm Saturday. 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 pm Sunday.

The **New** show hall is handicapped accessible, **Heated and Air-conditioned**.

All Championship, Premiership and Kitten entries will be scored for CFA Regional and National awards. CFA show rules will be strictly enforced. To obtain show rules, contact **CFA, 260 East Main Street, Alliance, OH 44601**

This is a non-vetted show. Claws of all entries must be clipped prior to benching. All entries must be free of fleas, fungus, mites and infectious diseases; inoculated against feline rhinotracheitis, feline enteritis and calici virus and rabies; and should be tested for feline leukemia before entry. Any entry suspected of having a parasite, skin disease or other illness will be removed from the show hall until cleared by a veterinarian, whose decision is final. Household Pets must be 4 months old to be entered and if over the age of 8 months must be neutered or spayed. No declawed cats are permitted. **No kittens under 4 months of age will be allowed in the show hall.** Single cages are approx. 22 x 22 x 22.

Novice exhibitors: Let us know if you are new to showing; we are happy to help you learn about CFA and showing. Please bring cage curtains, grooming aids, your own litter pans and food. People food will be available. Litter will be provided. All cats must be brought to the show hall in some sort of a carrier.

Many hotels are in the area. Information and directions will be provided with your confirmation.

All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with an Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number. Kittens may be entered without registration numbers, but will not be scored for CFA awards if a number is not provided at show time. Kittens without a registration number or TRN will not be included in the count.

It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calici virus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition. Per show rule 6.21 each entry must be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee. All online/fax entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. No substitutions after the closing date. No refunds after the entry clerk has confirmed your entry or for failure to bench.
