SHOW HALL: The Gwinnett Center is 45 minutes north of the Atlanta airport on I-85. The facility is air-conditioned and has ample free parking. Handicap access allows for rolling your carriers right into the show hall. Proof of the Pudding offers great lunches and snacks. The Civic Center is located at Exit #108 off I-85. You will see their marquee from the Interstate. This is a NO SMOKING facility. Phone(770)813-7500

AIRPORT SHUTTLE: If you are flying in, a rental car is your best choice; however, you can call AAA Air Express for a shuttle to the hotel. The cost is \$35 one- way. Simply go to Ground Transportation, Stall C7 (outside baggage claim). You can make advance reservations by calling (404) 767-2000. Shuttles run every hour, between 6 a.m. and 11 p.m. The drive from the airport to the hotel is approximately 1 hour.

SHOW HOTEL: ON Grounds of the Gwinnett Center. Holiday Inn Gwinnett Center: 6310 Sugarloaf Parkway, Duluth, GA 30097 (Exit #108 on I-85). SOUTHBOUND TO HOTEL: Travel I-85 to Exit 108 (Sugarloaf Parkway). Turn right onto Sugarloaf PKWY West. Continue straight traveling through the stop light at Satellite Boulevard. Take the very next left into Gwinnett Center. Take an immediate left into the Horizon Bank/Holiday Inn parking lot. **NORTHBOUND TO HOTEL:** Travel I-85 to Exit 108 (Sugarloaf Parkway). Merge right onto Sugarloaf PKWY West crossing under I-85. Continue straight traveling through the stop light at Satellite Boulevard. Take the very next left into Gwinnett Center. Take an immediate left into the Horizon Bank/Holiday Inn parking lot. 1BPlease help by keeping your room clean!

Exhibitors are urged to have all cats/kittens inoculated against Feline Enteritis, Rhinotracheitis, Calici Virus, and tested for FELV. All claws (back and front) must be clipped. Kittens under four months of age are not permitted in the Show Hall. Household Pets over the age of 8 (eight) months must be neutered or spayed. Cage size approx. 22x22x22

CFA RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. Copies of the current Show Rules may be ordered on line at www.cfa.org or by mail from CFA Central Office (1805 Atlantic Avenue, P.O. Box 1005, Manasquan, NJ 08736-1005). The cost of \$5.00 + \$2.00 shipping and handling must be included with your order.

All Championship, Premiership, and Registered Kittens will be scored for CFA National and Regional Points. Kitten registration numbers must be printed or written in ink in the Master Catalog in order to be scored. Rosettes will be offered in all rings for final Awards. Flats will be offered for all other awards in accordance with CFA Show Rules. Declawed cats are ineligible. There will be NO veterinary inspection prior to benching. All cats are expected to be free of fleas, fungus, ear mites, and any contagious diseases.
