Entry Info: Per show rule 11.08 a. entries *must* be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee; such entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to confirm receipt of online/faxed entries with the Entry Clerk. Additional Info: All championship, premiership and kitten entries with registration numbers will be scored for CFA National and Regional points. No declawed entries are permitted and all entry's front and rear claws must be clipped prior to benching. No kittens under 4 months are permitted in the show hall. Exhibitors must transport cats into and out of the show hall in an enclosed, secured carrier. Litter will be provided but not litter pans. Cage size is approximately 22"x22"x22" and must be covered on 3 sides and top. No exhibitor may leave cats or kittens in the show hall overnight. All benched entries, with the exception of kittens, must remain in the show hall until the advertised closing hour. Per show rule 11.01 any person entering a cat or kitten in a show held under the rules of CFA shall by such act agree to abide by, and this person and the entry of this person shall be subject to these rules. CFA show rules may be obtained for \$7 each from CFA, 260 E. Main St. Alliance, OH 44601.

Health: It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, calici viruses and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats must be free of fleas, ear mites, or any contagious or infectious illness.
