CFA SHOW Rules: This is a CFA licensed show and CFA show rules will be strictly enforced. Show rules may be obtained online at <http://www.cfa.org/client/Publications/CFAManuals.aspx> or a copy can be obtained from CFA for \$7 at 260 E. Main St., Alliance, OH 44603.

This is a non-vetted show. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), Feline rhinotracheitis, calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. Cats must be free of fleas, ear mites, fungus and any contagious illness. All claws must be clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for entry (including HHP). No kittens under the age of 4 months will be permitted in the show hall. All claws of entries must be clipped prior to benching. Registered and recorded entries will be scored for CFA regional and national awards.

LIABILITY: Frontier Feline Fanciers will take reasonable care to safeguard the property of exhibitors. Neither the club, its members or Johnson County 4-H Building will be liable for any loss or damage. The show hall is not air-conditioned though it is heated and handicap accessible. Smoking is allowed outside only.

SUPPLIES: Litter will be provided. Bring your own litter pans, cat food and dishes. A single cage is provided with each entry. Single cage size is 21" x 21" x 21"; double cage size is 21" x 21" x 45". Bring cage curtains or towels to hang on the inside, top and bottom of the cage.

NEW EXHIBITORS: Please go to www.cfanewbee.org for information on showing in CFA. Please let the entry clerk know on the entry form and tell the club representative at check in that you are new so that any questions you have can be answered.
