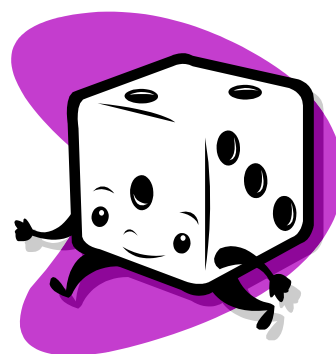

**Hours:** Check-in time is 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Judging begins promptly at 9:00 am. Advertised show hours are 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

**Show Hall:** The hall is climate controlled with air-forced heater/coolers. There is no food vendor on the premises. The show hall is NO SMOKING. Single cages are 21x21x21in; doubles are 21x21x45. No more than one cat or two kittens may be benched in a single cage. Litter will be provided. Please bring your own litter pan. The Lodi Grape Festival and Harvest Fair, High Sierra Cat Club and club members will not be responsible for any personal injury, loss or damage to personal property.

**Parking** is free.

**Directions:** From Sacramento going south on 99, exit on Lodi/Turner Rd. Go straight on Cherokee Lane and turn right onto E. Lockeford. Pass the main entrance of the fairgrounds, which is on the right, turn right through the large gate on the corner and into the parking lot.  
Going North from Stockton on 99, exit Central Lodi/San Andreas/Hwy 12. Turn left on Victor Road, right onto Cherokee Lane and Left onto Lockeford St.

**Show Hotel:** There is no specified show hotel. The following are options. Please be sure to recheck with each hotel to confirm their current pet policies.

**Entries:** Entries close Monday May 12, 2014 or when entry limit is reached. Please make checks payable to High Sierra Cat Club. Fees must be received with entries except fax or email entries which must be paid within 10 days of entry or at the show whichever comes first. Per show rule 11.08, once an entry is made, it may not be withdrawn and payment is required whether or not the entry is exhibited. Early bird entries must be received with fees no later than April 12, 2014. Faxed/email entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. There is a \$25 return check fee for any reason. Any entry for Championship, Premiership, Veterans, Provisional or AOV classes must be submitted with a CFA registration number. Benching requests are limited to one.

**Awards:** All championship, premiership and registered kittens (whose registration number is printed or written in ink in the catalog) will be scored for Regional and National awards in accordance with CFA show rules. A copy of the show rules may be obtained for \$7.00 by writing to the Cat Fanciers' Association, 260 E Main St Alliance, OH 44601. Show rules can also be obtained online at <http://www.cfa.org/Portals/0/documents/forms/12-13showrules.pdf> at no charge.

**Health:** This is a non-vetted show. However, any entry found with fleas, ear mites, fungus, or any signs of illness will not be admitted or will be removed from the show hall. All cats and kittens should be inoculated against feline enteritis, rhinotracheitis, calici viruses and should be tested for feline FeLV. All claws must be clipped prior to benching. No declawed cats may be in the show.
