A fee of \$50.00 will be charged for any checks returned by the bank for any reason. All checks must be drawn on US banks or paid in US funds. Email and faxed entries will be accepted at no additional charge. However, all electronic entries must be paid before the show starts.

Electronic or any entries not paid before the show, must be paid in CASH at the door. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to confirm fax was received. Club is not responsible for faxed entries not received due to communication errors.

Starting Times: The show hall will be open at 7:30 a.m. All cats must be benched by 8:30 a.m. or they will be marked absent. Judging will begin promptly at 9 a.m. on Saturday.

Cages are approximately 22"x22"x22". All entries should be inoculated against Feline Enteritis, Rhinotrachetitis, and Calici Virus and tested for FeLV by a licensed vet. Cats should be free of mites, fleas, and fungus.
