Enter Online at www.catshows.us Closing Date 5-31-08 or when 225 cats have been entered. Entries must be typed or printed legibly, signed and submitted on an official CFA entry form. All online entries must be confirmed by email or phone call to the Entry Clerk. All fees and benching request must accompany entries. Make checks payable to Half Moon Cat Club. Only one benching request per exhibitor will be honored. The entry clerk will call collect if questions arise concerning your entry. No emailed, phone entries or post dated checks will be accepted, and all funds must be in US currency.

We are limited on space, double cages, sales cages and grooming spaces are on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE basis.

THIS SHOW WILL START ON TIME. Check-in is from 7:00-8:00, any cat not benched by 8:00 will be marked absent. Judging will begin promptly at 8:30. Please report any transfers or absentees at check-in. All adult entries must remain in the show hall during advertised hours of 8:30- 4:00. Cage size is approximately 22"x22"x22", bring cage curtains (or coverings) to cover the sides, top and bottom of cage. New exhibitors are advised to bring cage drapes or towels, etc. for the floor, sides and top of the cage. Please advise the entry clerk if this is your first show. Litter will be provided but not litter pans.

Show Hall: 13 Port St. Hudson, MA 01749. The show hall is heated & air conditioned and handicapped accessible. People food will be available.
Show Hotel: Red Roof 367 Turnpike Road, Southborough, MA 508-481-3904. Those coming to the banquet only, without cats may want to stay at the Holiday Inn Express (Boston-Marlboro) 121 Coolidge St. Hudson, MA 978-562-1001, about 2 miles from the show hall.

All championship, premiership and kitten entries with registration numbers will be scored for CFA National and Regional points. No declawed entries are permitted and all entry's front and rear claws must be clipped prior to benching. No kittens under 4 months are permitted in the show hall or on the show grounds. No cats or kittens may be left in the show hall overnight. Only benched cats and kittens are permitted in the show hall, none may be confined in carriers. This is a non-vetted show, and all entries are expected to be inoculated against feline enteritis, rhinotrachetis, calici virus and rabies and to be tested negative for FeLv. The exhibitor of any entry showing evidence of fungus, fleas, ear mites or any contagious disease will be asked to remove that entry as well as their other entries from the show hall. By entering exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the judges and the show committee and to adhere to CFA show rules.
