Entry Info: Entries must be typed or printed clearly on an official CFA entry form or online. No phone or fax entries will be accepted. Online/fax entries must be confirmed by email with the Entry Clerk. All entries, except online/fax entries must be accompanied by full entry fee payment. All online/fax entries MUST be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first as per CFA Show Rule 6.21. Make checks payable to The North Atlantic Region. All checks must be paid in U.S. funds; please, no Canadian checks or postdated checks. Returned Check fee is \$50. No refund once your entry has been received or for failure to bench. Odd numbered entries with ANY size security cage must purchase an extra ½ cage space. Limit one bench and/or agent request per exhibitor. * Paid End of Row must be even numbered entries or a paid extra 1/2 cage. No EOR fee for handicapped exhibitors. Please advise the entry clerk if this is your first show.

Check-in: 7:30-8:30 am. Judging will begin at 9 am SHARP. Please report any transfers or absentees at check-in. Advertised hours: 9 am to 4 pm. All benched entries with the exception of kittens, Veterans and Household Pets, must remain in the show hall until the advertised closing hour.

Show Hall/Hotel: Sheraton Stamford Hotel, 700 East Main St. Stamford, CT 06901 Ph: 203-358-8400 Toll Free 800-325-3535. The show hall is airconditioned and handicap accessible. No Smoking. Room Rates: \$99 (+ taxes) Single/Double; \$119 (+taxes) Triple; \$139 (+taxes) Quad. No pet fees! Make reservations by Friday, May 27, 2016 to receive rate. The NAR Awards Banquet will also be held at this location.

Travel Info: Westchester County Airport (HPN) is approximately 9 miles from the hotel; Arriving passengers should make advance arrangements for pickup or use one of the airport's licensed vendors, DLC Ground Transportation Services or Limousine Service of Westchester. Metro North Stamford Station is 1 mile from the hotel; cabs meet most trains. Stamford Taxi: 203-325-2611.

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with an Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number. Kittens may be entered without registration numbers, but will not be scored for CFA awards if a number is not provided at show time. Kittens without a registration number or TRN will not be included in the count.

Show rule 2.19E The MISCELLANEOUS (Non-Competitive) CLASS is for any registered cat or registered kitten of a breed not accepted for Provisional Breed competition. Miscellaneous Class entries are examined by judges; however, no awards will be made in this class. All Bengal championship, premiership and kitten entries can enter under a TRN, but all Bengals in the show hall must be registerable, (5 generation pedigree with no wild blood).

Additional Info: Single cage size is approximately 22"x22"x22", bring cage curtains (or coverings) to cover the sides, top and bottom of cage. Litter will be provided but not litter pans. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must have

all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition.

This show will be conducted under current CFA rules. A copy of the rules may be obtained by sending \$7.00 to CFA, 260 E. Main St. Alliance, OH 44601.

Liability: The NAR will take reasonable care to safeguard the property of exhibitors. Neither the NAR nor the Sheraton Hotel will be liable for any loss or damage.
