Entry Info: Entries are accepted now. **You must enter each show separately.** Entry Fees include CFA & Regional surcharges. Please email entry clerk to confirm online entries. Per show rule 6.21 each entry must be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee. All online/fax entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. Make checks payable to CFA North Atlantic Region; US\$ checks only. **PayPal is NOT available for this show.** No refunds after the entry clerk has confirmed your entry or for failure to bench. No substitutions after the closing date. **Check your confirmation for accuracy and contact the entry clerk with any corrections BEFORE THE CLOSING DATE. Please advise the entry clerk if this is your first show and visit <http://www.cfanewbee.org>**

Check-in: 7:30-8 am Saturday & Sunday. **Show Hours:** Judging will begin at 8:30 am SHARP on Saturday and at 9am on Sunday. **Advertised hours:** 9 am to 4 pm both days.

Airport Info: Bradley International Airport (BDL) is about 20 minutes from the show hall. The show committee will not be able to provide transportation.

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of cats/kittens without registration numbers can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number. This show will be conducted under current CFA rules. A copy of the rules may be obtained by sending \$7.00 to CFA, 260 E. Main St. Alliance, OH 44601

Benching: Single cage size is approximately 22"x22"x22" and is included with your entry. **Use of ANY size security cage with a single will require purchase of an extra 1/2 cage space.** Bring cage curtains (or coverings) to cover the sides, top and bottom. Litter will be provided but not litter pans. No single space at EOR.

Health: It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition.
