All entries are expected to be free of fleas, fungus, and infectious diseases; you are strongly advised to have your cats and kittens inoculated for rhinotracheitis, calici, feline enteritis, RABIES and tested for FeIV prior to entry into Canada. All Championship, Premiership, and registered kittens will be scored for CFA National and Regional awards. CFA rules will be strictly enforced. The entry clerk will call COLLECT if your entry is incomplete or illegible.
