ENTRY INFORMATION: Entries for Championship, Premiership, AOV, and Provisional classes must have the registration number on the entry blank and printed in the catalog to be scored for CFA awards. Kittens may be entered without registration numbers, but will not be scored for CFA awards if a number is not provided at show time. Entry clerk will phone collect to clarify entries where necessary. No fees will be refunded for failure to bench. BENCHING requests will be honored wherever possible. One request or Agent allowed per exhibitor. NO negative benching requests. The club reserves the right to add judges not named to judge non-championship and Household pet classes. Kittens must be four months of age or older on opening day of show. Phoenix Feline Fanciers will not be responsible for damage, loss, personal injury, or loss of property. No cats may be left overnight in the show hall. There will be no vending from cages or groom spaces. No kittens under the age of 4 months, or cats not officially entered are allowed in the show hall.

MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO: Phoenix Feline Fanciers. No postdated checks. \$35 charge for returned checks. FEES must accompany a signed Entry Blank, unless Faxed or E-Mailed. ALL FAX or E-MAIL ENTRIES must be paid within 10 days or at check-in, whichever comes first, per CFA Rules.

SHOW HALL: Phoenix Convention Center, South Building, Hall G, 33 South 3rd Street, Phoenix, AZ 85004. Phone: 602-495-0331. There will be concessions available. No outside food or Grand parties please. The Show hall is climate controlled with heat/air conditioning and is handicap accessible. No smoking in the show hall.

Parking: The Phoenix Suns are providing discounted parking for \$8 per day. Their garage is at 333 E. Jefferson St. between 3rd and 5th St. – adjacent to US Airways Center and Chase Field. Access to the 5th Street loading dock is from Jefferson Street only. You may also unload at the front of the South Building but you MUST move your vehicle to the Jefferson Garage!

DIRECTIONS to the show hall: **From the I-10:** Exit at 7th Street and go south to Washington Street (one way running West) so you must turn right onto Washington. Turn left onto 3rd street. Turn left onto Jefferson St. (one-way running East) and get into the right most lane. The parking lot is on the right. Once you park, go out of the garage to the Jefferson St. and walk across Jefferson St. to access Hall G. The loading dock is accessible off Jefferson Street only (5th St. is one way going North). **From the I-17:** Exit at 7th Street and head north to Washington Street, make a left. Turn left on 3rd St. and continue as above.

SHOW HOTEL: Hilton Suites Phoenix, 10 E. Thomas Road, Phoenix AZ 85012. Group Code PFF. The daily rate includes a daily hot breakfast buffet. Rates: \$109/single; \$114/double; \$119 triple; \$124/quad. No pet fees!!! Cancellation required 48 hours prior to arrival. Complimentary self parking saves another \$11 per day – free breakfast, no pet fees, no parking fees!! Alternate Pet friendly hotels: Comfort Inn, 5050 N. Black Canyon Hwy, Phoenix, 602-242-8011, Pet Fee \$35. EconoLodge, 1520 N. 84th Drive, Tolleson, 623-936-4667, \$10 non-refundable pet fee - 2 pets per room. Studio Motel 6 Tempe (#6031), 4909 S. Wendler Drive, Tempe (I-10 at Baseline Road, Exit #155). There are other pet friendly hotels near the show hall, but always double check about allowing pets before making a reservation. NOTE: Make reservations early- this is top tourist season for the Phoenix area!!

Airport Shuttle service to the hotel is available using the Phoenix Metro Light Rail. Metro busses will take you from the airport terminals to the Washington Street station where you can take the Metro for \$1.75 to the Hilton – get off at the Thomas/Central Station and you are a block from the hotel – trains run every 10 minutes. Contained pets are allowed on the trains. Taxi rides from the Airport run about \$17.

CHECK IN AND JUDGING: Check in is 8:30 - 9:30 a.m. Saturday. Judging begins promptly at 10:00 a.m. Saturday and 9:00 a.m. on Sunday. Advertised Show Hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday and 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Sunday. No Cage may be dismantled during how hours without the Show Manager's approval.

BENCHING: Cages are 36" wide by 24" deep by 27" high. No Double Cage Charges. These are the Southern California cages. However, personal cages that exceed 36" in width will be charged an additional fee of \$35.00. Only one cat or 2 kittens per cage in accordance with CFA show rules. LITTER will be provided. Bring your own litter pans, cage drapes, cat food, and dishes.

HEALTH: This is a non-vetted show. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline enteritis, feline rhinotracheitis, and calici viruses and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All entries must be free of fleas or fungus. ALL CLAWS MUST BE CLIPPED PRIOR TO BENCHING. Declawed cats are not allowed for entry, per CFA show rules.

HOUSEHOLD PETS: Household pets must be four months of age or older on opening day of show. If eight months of age or older, they must be spayed or neutered. Cats should be bathed and claws clipped. HHP entries may not be declawed.
