Entry Info: It is up to the exhibitor to confirm all online or fax entries with the Entry Clerk; neither the club or the Entry Clerk will not be responsible for lost entries. Per show rule 6.21 each entry must be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee. All online/fax entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. No substitutions after the closing date. No refunds after the entry clerk has confirmed your entry or for failure to bench. Make checks payable to Seacoast Cat Club. **Single cat entries with ANY size security cage must purchase an extra ½ cage space.**

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with an Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number. Kittens may be entered without registration numbers, but will not be scored for CFA awards if a number is not provided at show time. Kittens without a registration number or TRN will not be included in the count.

Show Hall: Everett Arena 15 Loudon Rd. Concord, NH 03301 603-228-2784. The show hall is handicap accessible and climate controlled by industrial fans. People food will be available. **No cats may be left in the show hall overnight.**

Show Hours: Check-In: 7-8:30 am. Cats must be benched by 9 am or they will be marked absent. Judging: 9:30 am Saturday; and at 8:30 am on Sunday.

Advertised Show Hours: 9:30 am – 4:30 pm Saturday and 8:30 am – 3:30 pm on Sunday.

All CFA Show rules will be strictly enforced. Show rules are available at www.cfa.org or by sending \$7 to CFA 260 E. Main St. Alliance, OH 44601.

No kitten under the age of 4 months old is permitted in the show hall. Cats may not be confined in carriers. Cages are approximately 22"x22"x22". Exhibitors are advised to bring cage drapes or covers for the top, sides and bottom of the cage. Litter will be available, please bring your own litter pan. If this is your first show let the entry clerk know and visit <http://www.cfanewbee.org>

Household Pet Info: * only recorded HHPs will be scored for the award; for info on how to register your HHP and show HHPs go to <http://www.cfa.org/Shows.aspx>

Feline Agility Info: Go to <http://agility.cfa.org> for info on Agility ** Agility Entry includes extra ½ cage.

Health: It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition.

The State of New Hampshire mandates current rabies inoculation for all cats and health certificates current within 10 days for cats/kittens being sold; it is advisable that you bring your cat's certificate(s).
