On-line entry will be available via www.catshowentries.com and www.catshows.us Entry clerk will call collect if questions arise concerning your entry. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to confirm receipt of entries. Club is not responsible for on-line and faxed entries not received due to communication errors. Paid entries will be entered before on-line and fax entries.

Payments and fees: E-mail and faxed entries will be accepted at no additional charge if paid before the day of the show. **Entries paid at the door must be in cash.** A \$35 check fee will be charged on all returned checks. General: CFA Show rules will be strictly enforced. Copy of rules may be found at www.cfa.org/Publications/CFAManuals.aspx. All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition. All championship, premiership and kitten entries with registration numbers or temporary registration numbers will be scored for CFA National and Regional points. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number. Registration numbers for kittens can be submitted at the show to the master clerk. It is the Exhibitors responsibility to check entry confirmation and notify entry clerk of any errors.

Benching: All benching will be by exhibitor and no changes in assignment will be allowed without permission of the Show Manager. Cages are 22"W x 22"H x 22"D. Benchng request made at the time of entry will be honored whenever possible. No refunds for failure to bench.

People food: There will be no food available at the show hall. Judging will stop for 30 minutes to allow you to go out to nearby food places. Your own food/coolers are welcome.
