



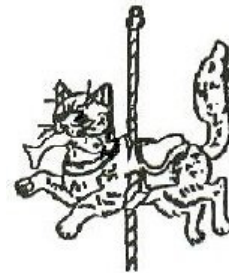

ENTRIES: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to contact the Entry Clerk to confirm receipt of online or fax entries. The Entry Clerk/Club will not be responsible for entries lost due to communication errors. Per show rule 6.21 each entry must be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee. All online entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. **Make checks payable Southern Tier Cat Fanciers; US\$ checks only. We do not accept PayPal.** Returned check fee is \$75. No substitutions accepted after the closing date. No refunds for failure to bench or once your entry is received. **Use of ANY size security cage with a single entry will require purchase of an extra 1/2 cage space. End of Row fee will be waived for handicapped exhibitors.**

SCORING: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with an Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number. Kittens may be entered without registration numbers, but will not be scored for CFA awards if a number is not provided at show time. Kittens without a registration number or TRN will not be included in the count.

SHOW HALL: Greater Binghamton Sports Complex 1500 Airport Rd. Binghamton, NY 13905 Phone: 607-729-5165. The show hall is heated and A/C (as needed), and is handicap accessible. People food will be available.

CHECK IN & SHOW HOURS: Check in: 7:30 – 8:30 am. Judging will begin at 9 am. Advertised show hours: 9 am – 4 pm.

BENCHING: Single cage size is approximately 22"x22"x22". Please bring cage curtains, fabric or towels to cover top, sides and back of cages. Litter will be provided; please bring food & water bowls and litter pans. Show Management will take all reasonable care to safeguard the personal property of exhibitors, however neither the club nor the hotel will be liable for loss or damage to such property. Cats Incredible, Inc. and Warwick Valley Feline Fanciers reserve the right to substitute judges in case of illness or emergency.

HOUSEHOLD PETS: It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition.
